SENIOR LEADERSHIP & COUNCIL: LEADERSHIP LAB

Through real-world examples and discussion, participants will learn how to assess service risks, set priorities, and manage the gap between expectations and available resources. The focus is not on doing more with less, but on doing what you can with purpose, backed by evidence and clear risk-based decisions.
