WHO ATTENDS THIS CONFERENCE?

• Municipal staff and elected officials, regulators and those who support asset management through the provision of services, tools and resources. We anticipate approximately 150 municipal staff, elected officials, provincial government and private sector participants to attend this year's conference.

SPONSORSHIP RULES:

- All sponsorship fees must be received at least three weeks prior to commencement of event to receive recognition at the event.

BRONZE sponsors receive a 25% discount for one person.
- Copy of signage, promotional materials, etc. must be provided to AIM Network for approval not later than August 18th, 2023.
- Sponsor recognition on website and promotional materials will commence as soon as feasible following payment of sponsorship fee. Sponsors should provide AIM Network with their logo.
